Low Well Water Alert

Unfortunately we had another dry year at Warm Lake and again our well did not recharge to its normal level. We are starting this year 30 feet lower than last year so conserving water is very critical. If we do not all work hard at saving water we have the potential of the well running dry by July.

Please, limit your use. Wash dishes once a day and flush the toilet at the most once daily.

The water right for Chipmunk has been in the Forest Services name since it was filed in 1937. We have filed over the top of the Forest Service and have been told by the Idaho Water Resource Dept. that the water right should pass on to us. The adjudication of this water right will take place next year but I feel that we are now in a position where we can count on having the water right to Chipmunk Creek, something that we needed to have in place before spending money on a water filtration system.

We are actively looking at filtration systems but this will not help us through this year. Please conserve water to the up most degree.
